Dear NFN Families:

We hope you will agree that Natick is truly lucky to have a free family support program like Natick Family Network. The Massachusetts Family Networks follow a philosophy of universal access, which means all families are welcome and included in all activities **free of charge**. This policy embraces the idea that all families can benefit from support regardless of background, education or income. There are many ways you might have experienced the unique support that NFN provides to families, including:

- formal support groups,
- multi-session playgroups or classes in early literacy, art, music, movement and personal safety
- the parent lending library,
- parent workshops focused on issues related to the young child,
- family events that build community,
- referrals to needed services in the Natick area.

Since NFN accepts no fees for services, we must rely on other funding sources. The Department of Early Education & Care provides an ongoing grant to continue a baseline of services, but with rising costs and growing family enrollment, NFN must increasingly rely on outside donations to ensure adequate quantity and quality of programs. A donation of \$10 could provide materials for a baby gift bag given to new parents. \$25 could buy craft materials for a weekend playgroup; \$50 would provide babysitting for an evening parenting program, and a \$100 contribution would support a parent-child program.

Natick Family Network begins its 9th program year in our community on July 1, and we hope it will be the best one yet. **Please show your support for NFN by sending a financial donation today. As little as \$10 per family could make a difference in the new program line-up**, which begins in September.
